

Hot Lunch Agreement

From the Handbook:

Lunch Charges: If a student has no funds available to pay for a meal, the student will be provided and charged for up to five meals. Thereafter, if a student has no funds available to pay for a meal, the student is provided a “courtesy meal,” such as a plain sandwich and milk, at no cost. If a student repeatedly lacks funds to purchase a meal and has **not** brought a meal from home, St. Paul’s will use its resources and contacts to protect the health and safety of the student. Failure or refusal of parents or guardians to provide meals for students may require mandatory reporting to child protection agencies as required by law.
